Answer:

1. The Chair of the CASA Board runs a process to identify suitable candidates for the Minister's consideration to fill vacant Board positions. CASA engages a third-party executive search firm to assist with this process and is responsible for exercising the relevant procurement requirements. On completion of the process, the Chair writes to the Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government with recommendations for preferred candidates to fill vacant position on the Board. This process was followed to identify potential candidates to replace Ms Marilyn Andre (term ended 30 June 2023). The process to replace Mr Michael Bridge (term ended 30 September 2023) is expected to be completed this calendar year.
